

BRI puts its energies into project cargo



Multimodal forwarder Bellville Rodair International (BRI) has put together a specialist team to meet the logistics requirements of the power generation and energy industries.

The company saw a 20% growth in business last year, reaching turnover of US\$108m.

In the energy sector, recent project movements have included transporting hydro-electric plant from Romania to Canada and windmill blades from Poland to Japan.

Paul Moldovan, leader of Bellville Rodair Energy Team (BRET), said: "Windmill blades is a highly specialised business. The blades can be more than 60 metres long and are vulnerable to damage.

The shipment has to be monitored carefully at all stages of the transport process." BRET members are located in key locations across BRI's worldwide network of offices.
